LET'S TELL YOU LAND SEA

The LandSea project aims to increase the professional skills and the ability of the actors interested in the development of the coastal strips to promote together the agricultural sector (activities, products) and the maritime sector (fishing and livestock) through innovation, the creation of new generating activities of income and the enhancement of its products.

The project includes:

- the preparation of training contents for the joint enhancement of land-sea products and the development of a self-assessment tool.
- the development of the LandSea guide which will provide a methodology to design, in a participatory way, LandSea discovery circuits suitable for each territory.
- the construction of a LandSea e-learning platform on which the training contents will be digitized to offer a free online learning path.

IThe project is funded by the Erasmus + program and is implemented by an international partnership made up of seven partners from six countries: Cyprus, Bulgaria, France, Italy, Spain and Greece. The project leader is the French cooperative Petra Patrimonia.




